Millie's Trust

There has been a lot of talk in the nursery sector in regards to paediatric first Aid training, in accordance with the statuary framework at least 1 member of staff should be paediatric first aid trained in each setting.

The government is ordering a review about whether to introduce mandatory pediatric first aid training for all nursery employees, thanks to the hard fight of Millie's Trust.

"Millie's Trust has been established following the loss of our daughter Millie in a choking incident at nursery in October 2012. As parents of a child ourselves we believe that everyone should have access to First Aid Training no matter what their situation in life is"

Following the death of Millie and the coroner's suggestion in December 2013 that ALL nursery nurses should be trained in paediatric first aid, Millie's parents are now campaigning to have it made law that everyone working in a nursery MUST be trained in Paediatric First Aid

Millie was a 9month old baby who sadly choked at a nursery and suffered a cardiac arrest. The first aid certificate of the staff member had run out so she was unable to give first aid.

At Pixies we have always made our peadatric first aid and safeguarding training a priority and are pleased to reassure you that 92% of our practitioners are first aid trained and these are renewed every 3 years. We will be updating these again in July and again early next year. If any parents have an interest to join us for these training session please do let us know and we could book you onto our course, please note there is a charge for this course.

We are in huge support of this Trust in the hope it will educate more people to save lives. You can find out more about this on the Millie's Trust website where you can sign the epetition to support Millie's Law.
